Information Regarding Traffic Restrictions & Road Closures

The An Post Ras stage will come into Drogheda via Termonfeekin, Baltray along the coast road up the Quay, turn right onto Shop Street to finish at the top of Peter Street on Saturday 23rd May between 2 and 3pm.

The race is not passing over James Street or the Morningtown road area, and there should be no disruption to the First Holy Communion ceremony in St Mary's Church. There will be some delay on the Baltray Road when the race is approaching Drogheda.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- the Dublin Road will NOT be closed
- access into Drogheda town across St Mary's Bridge, via the Bull Ring will be CLOSED
- the Marsh Road will NOT be closed but traffic may be heavier so allow extra time for travel
- anyone going from Le Cheile to the other side of Drogheda will have to use the Dual Carraigeway & the Bridge of Peace
